



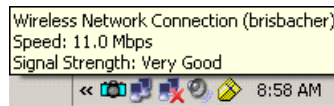
BPAL WiFi Point



The WiFi access is provided as is and no support is available from any member working in Biggles or behind the bar.

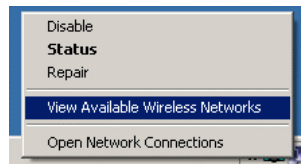
A brief how to do it for Windows XP.

With your wireless adapter drivers installed and the adapter connected or installed, start your PC. When your wireless network connection appears, you will see a balloon announcing it pop up from the taskbar.

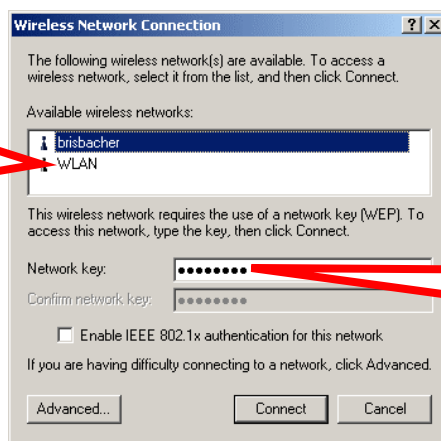


Right-click on the Wireless Network Connection icon to which the balloon points. If the balloon disappears before you have a chance to click, move the cursor over the icon, using the ToolTip to choose the wireless connection.

Choose View Available Wireless Networks from the menu.



You will see a list of all wireless networks in the upper portion of the window. Click on the BPAL network to select it. The BPAL network has NO WEP encryption key.
